## See You at the Pole!

Wednesday, September 27, 2017

For over 25 years, See You at the Pole has been about one simple act – prayer! SYATP is still about students uniting themselves in prayer before God interceding for their generation. All around the globe, in every time zone, students will be gathering at their flagpoles before school starts to pray for their school, friends, families, churches, and communities. This is a student- initiated, student-organized, and student-led movement of prayer. Pray for our youth to be bold for Jesus!

The 2017 theme verse for See You at the Pole™ is Hebrews 12:2. “. . . Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.” Pray that God will use SYATP to build up a core of students whose purpose will be to share the Gospel with non-Christian friends on campus. Ask God to bring spiritual awakening to His church. Use the #fixoureyes and #syatp to send out what God did at your See You at the Pole™ event.
