Big Words



- ☞ Righteousness – being morally right
- ☞ Propitiation – a bearing of God's wrath. Jesus, as our sacrifice took the wrath we deserve
- ☞ Redemption – propitiation led to redemption. A ransom was paid for our sins
- ☞ Justification – declares us righteous! Has a legal sense about it

Romans 3:21-26



✧ ²¹ But now apart from the Law *the* righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, ²² even *the* righteousness of God **through faith in Jesus Christ** for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; ²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, ²⁴ being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus; ²⁵ whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation **in His blood through faith**. *This was* to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed; ²⁶ for the demonstration, *I say*, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of **the one who has faith in Jesus**.
